Myross Wood House



Myross Wood House is one of the 6 MSC houses in Ireland. The majestic edifice serves as both a home for MSC confreres and a retreat center and is situated on south-west coast of Ireland near the village of Leap, about 70 km from the city of Cork.

The foundations of the house were laid in the middle of 18th century and some other extensions were made in early 19th century. In the course of the centuries several rich families occupied the large residence until 1943 when the last male heir of the Townshend family died. The property had to be sold.

In 1946, the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart bought it. We first used Myross Wood as a novitiate & study house for our own young religious, making some adaptations to suit its new purpose. Since 1970 it has served as a retreat center.
